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- Welcome to Whisky Fringe 2019 -

Regular visitors to Whisky Fringe at Mansfield Traquair will have felt only a reassuringly gradual change over the years. This, our 19th year, is actually very different and we think you will be delighted with the changes.

Firstly, we have expanded into an entirely new area. The marquee in the garden allows for 8 extra stands, and a little more room for creativity from our exhibitors. We urge you to make a beeline for this exciting space where we have new distillers like Isle of Raasay distillery and High Coast from Sweden, Stef Holt playing Pin The Whisky On The Country, an exciting relaunch of Cù Bòcan, plus a fully immersive Bunnahabhain experience. As if that wasn't enough, our own Drinkmonger stand is pouring the best non-whisky spirits to hit the market this year.

Building from the success of last year's Glen Scotia Roadshow, Loch Lomond are running an exciting distillation experience in the Raeburn Room (halfway down the stairs) which you must register for - please see a Loch Lomond Exhibitor or member of staff for details.

Elsewhere in the festival you will notice some fresh approaches from distillers. At the start of the year Royal Mile Whiskies challenged exhibitors to come up with some new concepts for the event, and they didn't disappoint. That Boutique-y Whisky Company are running a "silent disco" whisky tasting; Tomatin have brought a single cask down from the distillery, so you can buy an empty bottle from the shop and fill it straight from the cask; and Berry Bros. & Rudd are asking you to choose the next exclusive Royal Mile Whiskies bottling, so there is no shortage of creativity on show.

We hope you have a wonderful afternoon sampling some of the finest whiskies around.

To ensure maximum enjoyment of your day;

- Make sure you eat before sampling. You can also enjoy some food at the venue.
- Pace your sampling and know the strength of what you're trying.
- Drink plenty of water (refresh your palate, stay hydrated).
- Use the spittoons provided. You don't have to finish every dram.
- If you are in a group, please look after each other.
- Please don't be rude. The exhibitors have the right not to serve you.
- Remember to use your £10 off voucher at the RMW event shop.

- The Half Time Orange / Whistle -

At 4pm today make sure to listen out for the half time whistle. It is the signal to 'commence pouring' on some very exciting drams.

A number of our exhibitors have kindly agreed to bring along one single bottle of something extra special for you to try, at no extra charge. Stocks are limited and may run out depending on demand. A list of the Half Time whiskies can be found at the RMW Shop (Stand 28). The exhibitors will only be offering these drams from 4:00pm for a short period of time (approximately 15 minutes) or, simply, as long as the bottle lasts!

You may select only ONE of these special whiskies to sample, which can be exchanged for your half time orange token that you receive on arrival.



- A Short Guide to Appreciating Whisky -

It is recommended that you should aim to sample no more than 6 drams (be aware that some drams may be cask strength and above the standard 40% ABV). Always remember to keep yourself well hydrated in between drams. There are lots of water stations placed around the hall to help you with this.

For those still discovering whisky, we have put a few pointers in the program. A 'Staff Favourite' is a whisky that continually rates highly across our employees, and is a great place to start if you want to set a benchmark for a particular distillery. You'll also find a few lines introducing each company and what sort of whisky they make, so it's worth having an overall read of the programme before sampling. We'd recommend coming with a plan ready to help you navigate your route around the room!

-Nosing and tasting -

Appreciating a whisky involves nosing it just as much as actually tasting it; the Snifter glass provided is the best glass for this purpose. First, gently nose the dram. What aromas can you distinguish? There may be any number of the following and more; Phenols (peat and smoke) Esters (fruit or solvent) Floral (grass and flowers) Cereal (malty, yeasty) Wine (sherry and nutty) Woody (vanilla and toast) Sulphur (gas and rubber) Feints (tobacco and leather).

Take a little sip into your mouth, swirl it around and concentrate on the sensations. There are three elements to look out for if you really want to evaluate the whisky. The 'taste' itself is perhaps the most obvious element - does the whisky taste sweet, bitter, salty or sour? The two other elements are the 'mouth feel', which occurs before the whisky is swallowed - is the whisky astringent, drying, fizzy, mouth-watering? Finally, there is the 'finish' of the whisky - does it leave an aftertaste; how long does the flavour last for?

Next, add a drop of water. The strength of the alcohol might be a bit too powerful – so a little water will stop the strength of the whisky anaesthetising your senses and allow you to perceive more flavours. Add a drop or two of water at a time to get the right dilution. Individual tastes will vary, and each whisky is different so experiment with what you prefer.

Take a bit of time before moving onto a new whisky, to allow your taste buds to recover. There is water available throughout the hall, as well as oatcakes on all stands to help you cleanse your palate.






