- Welcome to our 13th annual Whisky Fringe -

Thank you for coming to Whisky Fringe 2014. All of us at Royal Mile Whiskies and Drinkmonger are proud of our modest but long-running event and we want everyone to enjoy their day. Our intention has always been to broaden people's knowledge of whisky in a convivial and relaxed atmosphere. To achieve this aim we rely on a great deal of goodwill, mutual respect and co-operation between ourselves, the exhibitors, the venue owners and the local authorities. Should we lose any of these elements of trust then Whisky Fringe may cease to exist. Please bear this in mind during the day and behave in a responsible manner. It only takes one numpty to ruin it for everybody. Don't be that numpty. Pace your sampling, drink plenty of water, use the spittoons, take a break if necessary. You can't try all the products on show so make use of this programme and plan your tasting accordingly. Remember, whisky is at least 40% alcohol by volume – 4 x the strength of wine and 10 x the strength of beer!

For the first time we are running a shop on site at the venue. This will be stocking a select range of approximately 140 products. Available bottles are marked in the programme with an asterix (*) next to their list price. Any bottle not available from the venue shop should be available from our shop on the Royal Mile or online (ask shop staff for details). Please note that all venue purchases will be kept safely for you until the end of the day when they can be collected upon leaving. (See RMW Event Shop page for full details)

To ensure maximum enjoyment of your day;

- Don't drink on an empty stomach
- Pace your sampling
- Drink plenty of water (refresh your palate, stay hydrated)
- Use the spittoons provided
- If you are in a group please look after each other.
- Don't be rude. The exhibitors have the right not to serve you.
- Remember to use your £10 off voucher at the RMW event shop.
- Don't forget to vote for your favourite dram to enter the prize draw.
- Last sample pour at 5.45 pm to allow ample drinking up time before 6 pm finish.

- The Half Time Orange/Whistle -

Listen out for the Half Time whistle, due today at 4.00 pm. It is the signal to 'commence pouring' on a very select few drams.

A variety (but not all) of our exhibitors have kindly agreed to bring along one single bottle of something special for you to try today, at no extra charge.

Details of what will be available will only be revealed once doors open on each day.

This is a one off special, exclusively organised by RMW for Whisky Fringe and stocks are severely limited. The exhibitors are under strict instruction to have their special bottle available only from 4.00 pm for just a short window of time (approximately 15 minutes) or for simply as long as the bottle lasts.

A menu listing the Half Time whiskies being offered on the day will be situated in the centre of the main hall, on the wooden easels.

You may select only ONE of these prestigious whiskies to sample.

Be ready just before 4pm, with an empty glass and your Half Time Orange token. Assemble at your chosen stand, then simply exchange the token for a measure and enjoy!

- A Short Guide to Appreciating Whisky -

If you are relatively new to whisky here is our regular guide to a sensible way to discover the enormous variety of whiskies that are available. It is recommended that you should aim to sample no more than 5 or 6 drams (be aware that some drams may be Cask Strength and above the standard 40% ABV). Always remember to keep yourself hydrated in-between drams.

Below is a key to helping you choose a whisky. The idea is to start with a 'Light' (number 1) and work your way towards the 'Heavily full-bodied' (number 5)

- (1) Light; aperitif-style, sweet
- (2) Moderate; fruity, floral
- (3) Medium; robust, light spice, some smoke
- (4) Full bodied; rich, dried fruits, sherried
- (5) Heavy; peaty, smoky

-Nosing and tasting -

Appreciating a whisky involves nosing it just as much as actually tasting it; the Snifter glass provided is the best glass for this purpose. First gently nose the dram. What aromas can you distinguish? There may be any number of the following and more; Phenols (- peat and smoke) Esters (- fruit or solvent) Floral (- grass and flowers) Cereal (- malty, yeasty) Wine (- sherry and nutty) Woody (- vanilla and toast) Sulphur (- gas and rubber) Feints (- tobacco and leather).

Next, add a drop of water. It's worth trying a little without water first to see how it tastes, but the strength of the alcohol might not allow too much flavour to be tasted – so a little water will help to make the drink less fierce and stop the strength of the whisky anaesthetizing your senses and reducing the taste you will enjoy. Add a little water at a time to get the right dilution. Individual tastes will vary so experiment with what you prefer – some whiskies will be best without water.

Take a little sip into your mouth, swirl it around and concentrate on the sensations. There are three elements to look out for if you really want to evaluate the whisky. The 'taste' itself is perhaps the most obvious element - does the whisky taste sweet, bitter, salty or sour? The two other elements are the 'mouth feel', which occurs before the whisky is swallowed - is the whisky astringent, drying, fizzy, mouth watering? Finally there is the 'finish' of the whisky - does it leave an aftertaste; how long does the flavour last for?

Take a bit of time before moving onto a new whisky, to allow your taste buds to recover. There is water available throughout the hall, as well as oatcakes on all stands to help you cleanse your palate.

Re-admittance with purchases will not be allowed. The venue has requested we strictly prohibit purchased bottles from the function rooms.


